Flick Ford's Striped Bass

Artist Flick Ford caught a trophy striped bass off the coast of Massachusetts this summer and quickly measured, photographed, and released it back into the waves. Returning to his studio, he set about to reproduce the 39-inch, 25-pound bass as faithfully as possible—the result is a new classic portrait of our most sought-after species of saltwater gamefish. Ford used watercolors to capture every detail of this beautiful fish, and it's the perfect addition to any saltwater angler's home, office, vacation house, or business.

A talented musician and graphic artist, Ford began painting fish in the mid-1990s because “I felt I should start to keep a record of the fish I caught. I wanted to catch and paint these fish, and show how they appear to me in all their iridescent beauty.”

Ford's current paintings are collected in two books *Fish: 77 Great Fish of North America* (Greenwich Workshop Press, 2006) and *Big: The 50 Greatest World Record Catches* (Greenwich Workshop Press, 2008).
